Thoughts For October

6 Oct - Today's readings all point towards building resilience. Being resilient is a habit we need to teach and encourage, especially in our young people. The gift of faith, and the gift of Jesus' journeying through life with us is something worthy of our gratitude, and will help us in times of trouble and joy alike.

13 Oct - Illness and pain are no respecters of privilege or position. Something shared among all humanity is the experience of illness and suffering. Yet, we are reminded today that there is always hope. Also, Jesus teaches us through the Gospel reading today that there is a difference between being cured and being healed.

20 Oct - Each week, we are challenged to wrestle with the Scriptures, as we discern God's guiding hand in our lives and in the life of the world. This is not always easy - there are barriers of translation, context, and the presumptions we all bring. Being faithful to God in our study of Scripture involves getting stuck in, dealing with difficult topics, relying on the tremendous resource of 2000+ years of theology and tradition, and being humble enough to admit our own blind spots.

27 Oct - The readings today remind us of the extraordinary grace that comes to us as a gift of God. Paul knew this grace, and it gave him an extraordinary capacity for resilience, and a tremendous capacity to forgive and let go any resentment or animosity. We are reminded that this grace is God's gift, and we are not to be self-congratulatory over engaging with it.
